She has participated in nine arctic expeditions and completed a thru-hike of the Appalachian Trail.



Pam is the author of *Ellie's Long Walk*, *Hug a Husky*, *Douggie* and, along with Ann Dixon, is the co-author of *Alone across the Arctic: One Woman's Epic Journey By Dog Team* and *Big Enough Anna*.

Pam has spoken to more than 700,000 students at over 1,200 schools and has spoken at the Smithsonian, the St. Louis Science Center, and hundreds of public libraries.
